

SWINE DEPARTMENT 5

1. Read General Rules, Livestock Rules and Health Regulations carefully.
2. All animals must have been owned or leased by the exhibitor on or before June 1 of this year.
3. Entries (Livestock and Master Forms) must be accompanied by an entry fee of \$3.00 per animal. There will be a one-time \$2.00 entry fee for static displays in lots 4-7.
4. Entries must arrive Thursday, August 22nd between 5:30 and 9:30 pm.
5. Copy of current Health Certificate must be presented to Department in advance of entry to the fairgrounds.
6. Exhibitors may make a maximum of two entries per Lot, with the exception of Fitting and Showmanship, in which only one animal may be entered. If multiple animals are brought by the same exhibitor, they do not need to designate specifically which animal they will be using for Fitting and Showmanship, but they do have to register for the correct Class and Lot of Showmanship and Fitting.
7. Swine must be trained to be shown in ring.
8. Ages of swine will be computed as of September 1.
9. Proper 4-H dress code, white or tan pants or skirt and white shirt, must be observed when showing.
10. Exhibits must be prepared, handled and maintained entirely by the 4-H'er without assistance from parents or friends unless prior approval is given by the Department Chairman.
11. Exhibitors must have a pig board.
12. Show times to be announced.
13. Market hogs entered may be either barrows or gilts.
14. All animals entered in Class A and Class B are eligible for Reserve and Grand Champion.

Lot 04. Swine Exhibit – Make an interactive exhibit to be used with the public to educate them about swine. Exhibit should be made to withstand handling by the public.

Lot 05. Decorative Flag – Create a decorative or garden Flag. Decorative flags must be between 27" and 32" wide and 37" to 54" long. Garden flags should be between 11" and 15" wide and 15" to 18" long, with a channel along one side so that it can be easily hung. The theme of the flag should be swine. Material should be a durable fabric of your choice. Designs can be cut out and sewn on or painted with fabric paint.
